MOTION TO ADOPT TAX RATE

Following is the language for adopting the District's tax rate if it exceeds the no-new-revenue rate:

A motion to adopt an ordinance, resolution, or order setting a tax rate that exceeds the no-new-revenue tax rate must be a record vote, where the vote of each board member is recorded individually and must be made in the following form:

"I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.100000 per \$100, which is effectively an 8.11 percent increase in the tax rate."

The minutes of the meeting must also contain this language for the motion and the record vote results.

WEBSITE POSTING UPON ADOPTION OF TAX RATE

The District must post language on the home page of its website regarding an adopted tax rate that exceeds the no-new-revenue rate immediately upon adopting such a tax rate, and additional language must be included if the adopted tax rate exceeds the *no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate*. The complete statement is as follows:

"MEDINA COUNTY ESD NO. 6 ADOPTED A TAX RATE THAT WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 6.66 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$6.24."
